In order to complete the certification process, the Election Commission in each county must work with the county election officials by following the steps below. This form must be completed and returned with the certified SEMS Recapitulation (Recap) Report and your Voting System (VS) Server Election Summary Report.

Initials

1. SGR All Memory Cards/sticks have been uploaded to the VS Server.
2. SGR All accepted absentee ballots have been scanned and uploaded to the VS Server.
3. SGR All emergency ballots have been scanned and uploaded to the VS Server.
4. SGR All approved regular affidavit ballots have been scanned and uploaded to the VS Server.
5. SGR All approved Voter ID and Absentee affidavit ballots (ballots on Hold) have been scanned and uploaded to the VS Server.
6. SGR Any hand counted ballots have been manually entered into the VS database prior to final SEMS import.
7. SGR If not electronically importing into SEMS, all vote totals including hand counted ballots using the results from VS Server, have been manually entered into SEMS.
8. SGR The Election Summary Report has been printed from VS Server with final vote totals.
9. SGR The election is Certified in SEMS and the Official SEMS Recap Report has been printed with final vote totals.
10. SGR The vote totals for each candidate have been reconciled between the SEMS Recap Report and the VS Election Summary Report.
11. SGR The signature page of the SEMS Recap report must be signed by at least three of the officials in charge of the election.
12. SGR This form, the SEMS Recap report with Signature page, and the VS Election Summary report must be emailed (**ElectionsAnswers@sos.ms.gov**) or faxed (**601-576-2545**) to complete the certification process.
